- 1) Are muzzle devices allowed in stock class?
 - a. No, also no ported barrels
- 2) What are the distances & round counts for Rim Fire, Stock, and Unlimited/Open categories?
 - a. Distances: 9ft, 15ft, 25ft, 30ft, 50ft, 75ft
 - b. Round count: 48 (8 per target position)
- 3) What are the distances & round counts for Pocket/Sub Category?
 - a. 9ft, 15ft, 25ft, 30ft, 40ft, 50ft
 - b. Round: 30 (5 per target position)
- 4) What is the target profile?
 - a. NRA D-1 Tombstone (Target is switched after 3rd position)
- 5) What type of shooting will be involved?
 - a. One- or two-handed freestyle
- 6) Will this be shot indoors or outdoors?
 - a. Indoors
- 7) Will indoor lighting be adequate for all-black sights?
 - a. Yes
- 8) Will there be any "sighting" shots allowed prior or during the match?
 - a. No
- 9) What category does my S&W 469 fit in?
 - a. Pocket/Sub-compact
- 10) What is the time allowed per target distance?
 - a. 15 seconds
- 11) Will ammunition be available for purchase at the venue?
 - a. Yes
- 12) Do I need a holster to compete?
 - a. No holster is required for the match, however all firearms must be cased or holstered while entering and exiting the building.
 - b. ALL FIREARMS TO REMAIN UNLOADED UNTIL SHOOTER IS ON THE FIRING LINE
- 13) How many magazines do I need?
 - a. It is recommended to have at least 3 magazines, 6 is preferred.
- 14) Can we shoot in multiple categories?
 - a. Yes, the entry fee is per entry per category.
